#### Rum

# Ron Santiago de Cuba 12 Year Old Extra Añejo £8.50

Nose: Good helpings of thick, rich caramel and sweet fruits - think orange segments and dried cherry.

Palate: Quite nutty at first, though the fruit notes swiftly return (more tropical than before).

Finish: Burnt sugar and a touch of banana.

## Diplomático Reserva Exclusiva £12.50

Nose: Aromatic with hints of sultanas, chocolate, Christmas cake and gingerbread.

Palate: Cocoa and vanilla, huge notes of oaky spice, brandy, plums, and pepper.

Finish: Sweet coffee, Demerara sugar and oak.

## Eldorado 21 £16.50

Nose: Buttery, with chocolatey notes of Rolos behind it. Ripe banana and fruity Christmas cake. Hints of tobacco and sandalwood, leading into spent match smokiness.

Palate: Sultanas, dates, blackcurrant and macadamia nuts, dark chocolate and nutmeg too..

Finish: It just keeps going! Banana and notes right through to the end, with just a little hint of spicy cinnamon.

#### Whisky

### Arran 10 Year Old £8.50

Nose: Herbal, biscuity, hedgerow greenness and dried grass, like a long English summer's afternoon.

Palate: Sweet. Quite malty, digestive biscuits, followed by green fruits and Cox's apple peel.

Finish: Slightly bitter, maltiness.

# Nikka Coffey Malt Whisky £12.50

Nose: Fresh and clean, with aromas of candied lemon peel and rich cake spices.

Palate: Robust and spicy, richly textured, with cinnamon, clove, and citrus-tinged freshness to lighten the load.

Finish: Harmonious blend of dense spices, rich oak, and lemon and orange notes. Delightful.

#### Glenfiddich 21 Year Old Reserva Rum Cask Finish £17.50

Nose: Barley sugar, malt and dark brown sugar, marmalade, manuka honey, chocolate and foam bananas.

Palate: Full, fruitcake, spices, buttery vanilla, malty, with oak and candied ginger.

Finish: Long, with notes of mochaccino and marmalade.

#### Cognac

# Rémy Martin 1738 Accord Royal £8.50

Nose: Ripe fruit and vanilla with a slightly herbal vinous note.

Palate: Rounded and balanced vanilla and dried fruits.

Finish: Pronounced, but not overpowering, oak finish.

#### Hine Bonneuil 2008 £12.50

Nose: Vanilla, toasted almonds and buttery brioche lead among strong oak.

Palate: Candied apricot, toffee apples and stem ginger combine on the palate.

Finish: Rich honey lingers.

#### Hermitage 1987 Chez Richon Grande Champagne Cognac £19.50

Nose: Aroma is very pleasant with Ripe fruit and vanilla Palate: This is extremely rich and very balanced in taste. Finish: Perfect, long lasting oaky finish.
